

Teen Analysis Multimedia Presentation

Review this set of requirements to identify ways to improve your presentation before you submit it for grading. Give yourself a ✓ if present, a ✓+ if the criteria was completed exceptionally well, and a - if the area needs additional work.

CONTENT (50 points)	EVALUATION
1. Introduces novel, including book title, author, publisher, number of pages, time period, and age-appropriateness.	
2. Introduces character.	
3. Identifies and defines the context and areas of psychosocial development selected for analysis.	
4. Identifies significant aspects of the character's development during adolescence (based on context and areas selected).	
5. Explains pressing issue(s) the character must resolve as part of story.	
6. Explains how specific factors of the context are affecting the course of his/her psychosocial development.	
7. Explains to what extent the character's development is typical (i.e., corresponds or does not correspond to current research).	
FORM (35 points)	EVALUATION
1. Each context/area discussed is supported by minimum of 3 excerpts/quotes from novel and textbook (each).	
2. Reference slide is provided; references are in APA format; copyrighted images are properly acknowledged next to the image (i.e., © Author, Year OR © URL).	
3. Presentation content is clear, organized, and coherent.	
MULTIMEDIA (15 points)	EVALUATION
1. Creative use of visual effects enhances project. Images are meaningful. Animation and slide transitions are appropriate and do not detract from the content.	
2. Beginning of presentation includes title of report, report author's name, title of book reviewed, and book author's name.
